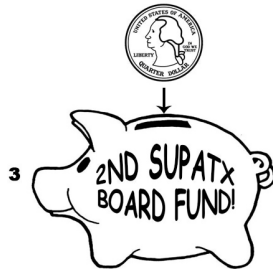

INSERT A COIN INTO THE SLOT ON THE VENT PLUG. TURN CLOCKWISE UNTIL SNUG. THIS VENT PLUG DOES NOT REQUIRE ANY REMOVAL OR MAINTENANCE UNLESS DEBRIS ARE VISUALLY BLOCKING THE 2 ROUND VENT HOLES ON TOP OF THE PLUG.

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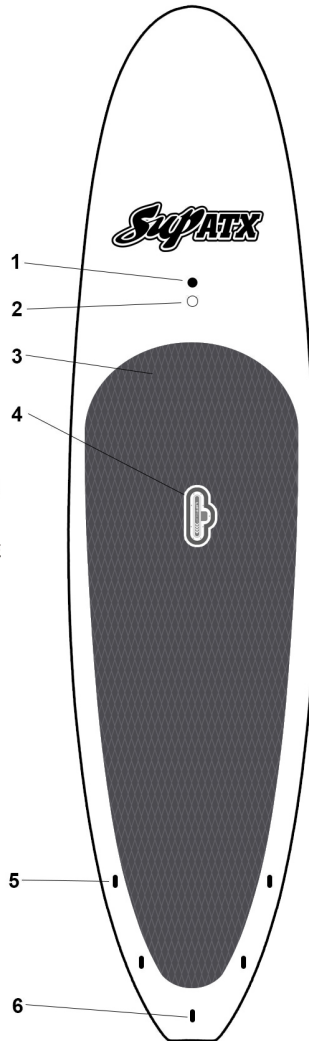

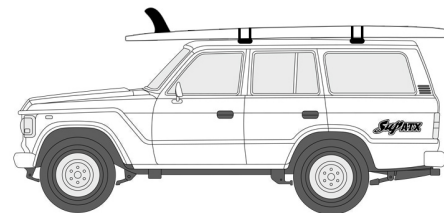

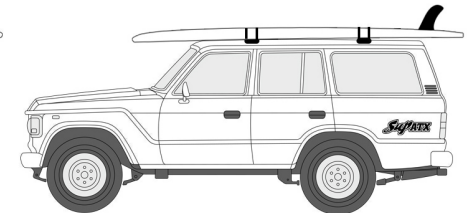


**WHEN STRAPPING TO ROOF, BOARD SHOULD BE BOTTOM SIDE UP.**

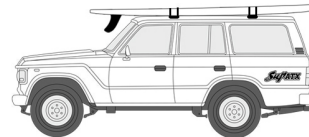
When securing your paddleboard to the roof of a vehicle, always place the board bottom side up. Placing the board topside up will create wind drag and instability while driving. Placing board nose forward or tail forward are both acceptable means of transport .

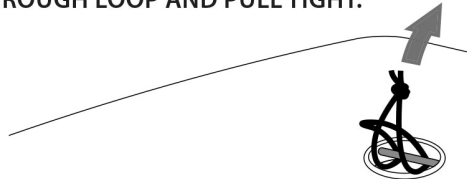
NOT INCLUDED | OPTIONAL ACCESSORY UNLESS NOTED

APPLIES TO THE SUP ATX STANDARD LEASH AND COIL LEASH

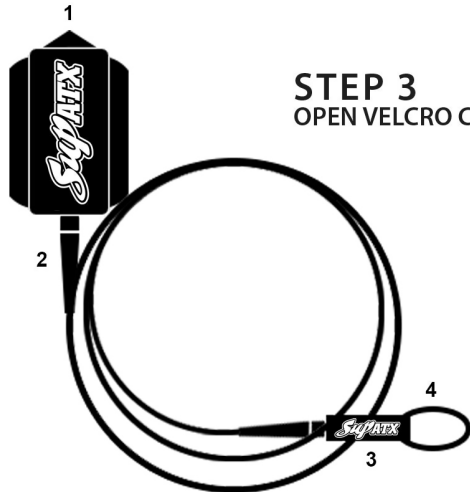
**STEP 1**  
PULL LEASH LOOP THROUGH EYELET.



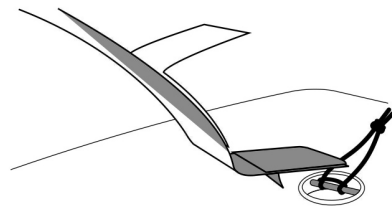
**STEP 2**  
PULL KNOT THROUGH LOOP AND PULL TIGHT.



**STEP 3**  
OPEN VELCRO CUFF AND ATTACH LEASH TO LEASH LOOP.

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## SECTION 2

### SUP ATX CARE AND MAINTENANCE



## KEEP IN A WELL VENTILATED, SHADED AREA WHEN NOT IN USE.

DIRECT SUNLIGHT CAN RESULT IN DELAMINATION OF A BOARD IF LEFT EXPOSED FOR A PERIOD OF TIME. DELAMINATION IS CHARACTERIZED BY A SEPARATION OF THE BOARD'S CORE FROM THE PROTECTIVE EPOXY SKIN. DELAMINATION IS A DAMAGE THAT IS NOT REPAIRABLE AND SHOULD BE AVOIDED AT ALL COSTS. KEEP YOUR BOARD IN AN AREA WITH GOOD AIR FLOW AND CIRCULATION. LEAVING YOUR BOARD IN A VEHICLE DURING THE DAY (CLOSED OR OPEN) ELEVATES THE RISK FOR DELAMINATION.



## LIMIT EXPOSURE OF DIRECT SUNLIGHT TO THE DECK-SIDE OF THE BOARD.

WHILE THE BENEFITS OF A NON-SLIP TRACTION PAD ARE OBVIOUS, THEY ALSO INCREASE THE RISK OF OVERHEATING AND DELAMINATION. WHILE IN USE, WATER FLOWING OVER THE DECK HELPS TO REGULATE SURFACE TEMPERATURE. BUT WHEN THE DECK TRACTION PAD IS DRY, THE EFFECTS OF HEAT ABSORPTION ARE AMPLIFIED WHEN EXPOSED TO DIRECT SUNLIGHT. IF YOU MUST EXPOSE YOUR BOARD TO DIRECT SUNLIGHT DURING TRANSPORT OR TEMPORARY STORAGE, IT IS SAFEST TO KEEP THE WHITE (BOTTOM) FACING UP.



## OVERHEATING YOUR PADDLEBOARD IS NOT COVERED BY THE MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY!

**YOUR COMPLETED PADDLE LENGTH WITH HANDLE SHOULD BE 8" - 10" ABOVE YOUR HEIGHT. EXAMPLE: IF YOU ARE 6' YOUR PADDLE SHOULD BE 6'8" - 6'10"**

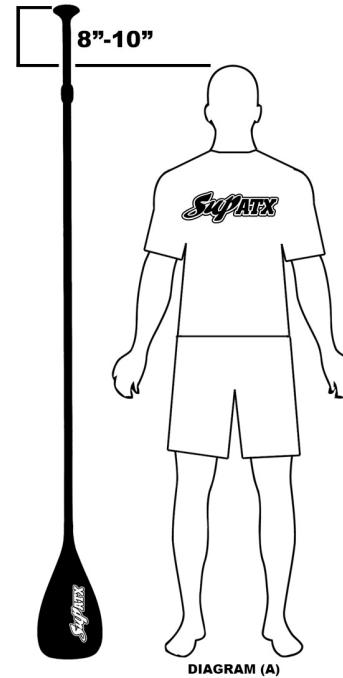
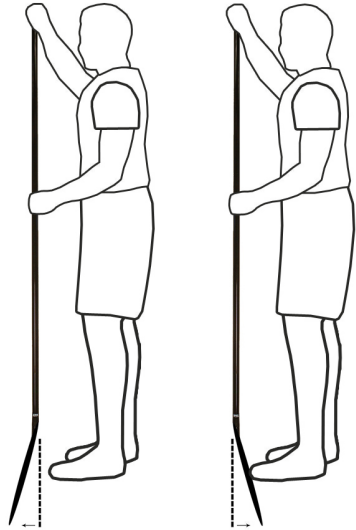

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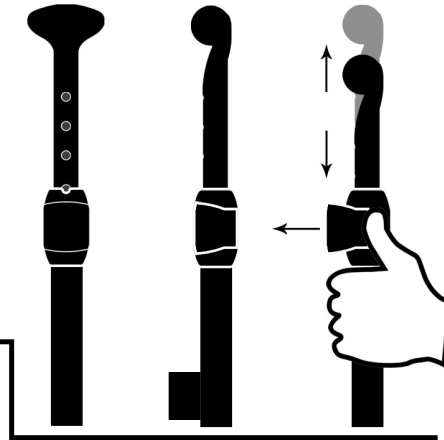
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## SECTION 3

### PADDLE ADJUSTMENT

**YOUR SUP ATX CARBON FIBER ADJUSTABLE PADDLE IS CAPABLE OF ACCOMMODATING PADDLERS FROM 4'10" - 6'4". TO ADJUST, SIMPLY GRASP THE PADDLE USING BOTH HANDS AND USE YOUR THUMBS TO PUSH OUT THE ADJUSTABLE COLLAR UNTIL IT CLICKS. THIS WILL FREE THE ADJUSTABLE HANDLE STEM AND ALLOW YOU TO RAISE OR LOWER TO YOUR DESIRED HEIGHT. ONCE SATISFIED, LINE UP THE HOLES WITH THE ADJUSTABLE COLLAR AND PRESS BACK INTO PLACE.**



**FIXED LENGTH PADDLE SIZING AND CUTTING**  
YOUR FIXED LENGTH PADDLE COMES UNASSEMBLED AND NEEDS TO BE CUT AND GLUED BEFORE USE.

**THINGS YOU WILL NEED:**

**MEASURING TAPE - HACKSAW - 5 MINUTE EPOXY - RAGS  
ACETONE-MASKING TAPE**

#### STEP 1.

**FIGURE OUT YOUR DESIRED PADDLE LENGTH USING  
DIAGRAM (A)**

#### STEP 2.

**MEASURE FROM BLADE TIP UP TO YOUR DESIRED  
LENGTH AND MARK YOUR CUT LINE.**

**NOTE: DONT FORGET TO FACTOR IN THE LENGTH OF  
THE HANDLE IN THIS MEASUREMENT.**

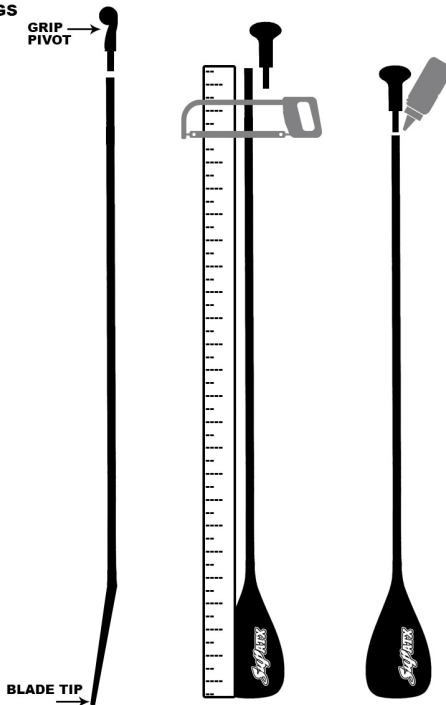
#### STEP 3.

**USING YOUR HACKSAW ON A FLAT  
SURFACE, CUT THE PADDLE SHAFT AT DESIRED  
LENGTH. TAKE YOUR TIME.**

#### STEP 4.

**MIX EPOXY FOLLOWING THE MANUFACTURES  
INSTRUCTIONS AND APPLY TO THE HANDLE INSERT  
AND INSIDE THE PADDLE SHAFT WHERE THE  
HANDLE WILL SLIDE INTO. BE SURE TO MAKE SURE  
THE HANDLE GRIP PIVOT IS FACING OUTWARDS IN  
THE SAME DIRECTION OF THE BLADE LOGO.  
THERE WILL BE AN OVERFLOW OF EPOXY SO BE  
SURE TO KEEP RAGS AT THE READY AND NOT TO  
DRIP ON ANY SURFACES SUCH AS YOUR PRIZED  
PERSIAN RUG.**

**YOU HAVE LESS THEN 5 MINUTES TO MAKE ANY  
ADJUSTMENTS BEFORE THE EPOXY STARTS TO  
SET. WORK QUICKLY. LEAVE PADDLE TO SET FOR  
30 MINUTES OR MORE WHILE A SOLID CURE IS  
ESTABLISHED.**



## RINSE SAND AND SALT WATER DEPOSITS FROM YOUR BOARD AFTER USE.

SUN, SAND AND SALTWATER WILL DEGRADE ANY MAN-MADE MATERIAL OVER TIME. RINSE OFF SAND AND SALTWATER DEPOSITS FROM YOUR PADDLEBOARD WITH FRESH WATER AND STORE IN A COOL, DRY ENVIRONMENT AFTER EACH USE.



## INSPECT YOUR BOARD FOR DINGS AND CRACKS BEFORE AND AFTER EACH USE.

TO PREVENT YOUR BOARD FROM BECOMING WATERLOGGED (HEAVINESS AND DRAG AS A RESULT OF WATER ABSORPTION), REGULARLY INSPECT THE EXTERIOR FOR DINGS AND CRACKS. IF YOU SPOT A CRACK, PATCHING WITH EPOXY IS THE PREFERRED METHOD OF REPAIR.

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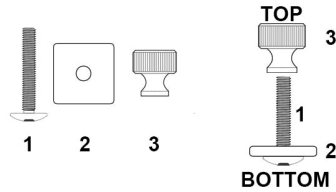

### FIN INSTALLATION

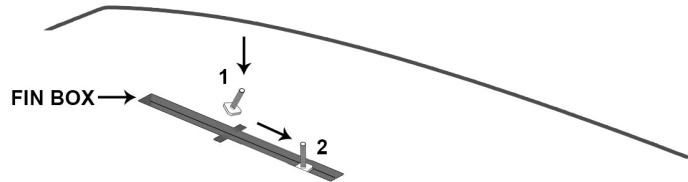
SUP BOLT HARDWARE PROPER CONFIGURATION

1. BOLT 2. BOLT PLATE 3. THUMB NUT



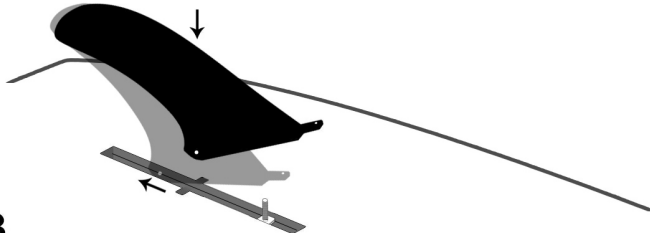
### STEP 1

INSERT BOLT AND PLATE CONFIGURATION INTO SLOT IN FIN BOX AT A SLIGHT ANGLE UNTIL BOLT AND PLATE ARE RESTED IN THE INNER SLOT OF THE FIN BOX. ONCE IN SLIDE THE BOLT AND PLATE TOWARDS THE FRONT OF THE BOX AND LEAVE THERE UNTIL STEP 3.



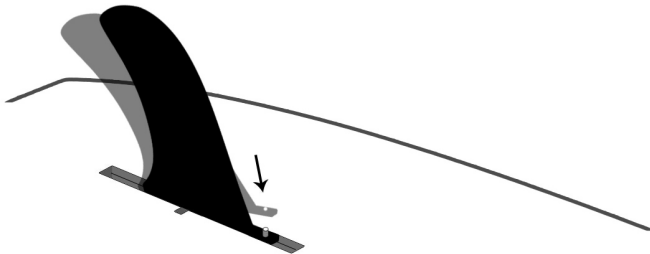
### STEP 2

INSERT FIN INTO BOX AT SLIGHT ANGLE. THE ROUND PIN AT THE BACK OF THE FIN WILL REST ON THE INNER SLOT OF THE FIN BOX. ONCE INSERTED MOVE FIN BACK WHILE KEEPING IT AT AN ANGLE.



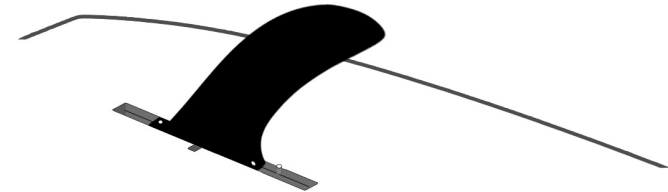
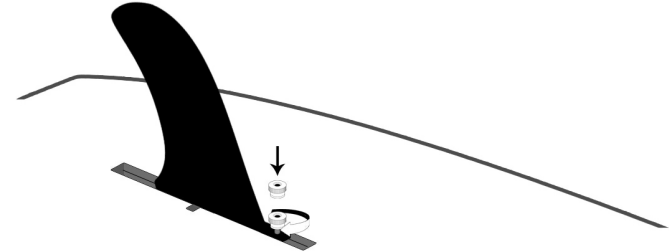
### STEP 3

LOWER THE FRONT TAB OF THE FIN INTO THE BOX WHILE LINING UP THE BOLT AND THE FIN'S FRONT TAB HOLE. PUSH DOWN UNTIL FIN TAB IS FLUSH WITH FIN BOX. NOTE: PLACEMENT OF THE FIN AT EITHER FRONT OR BACK OF THE FIN BOX DOES NOT MATTER.



### STEP 4

THREAD THE THUMB NUT ONTO THE BOLT UNTIL HAND TIGHTENED. NOTE: CHECK THE NUT EACH TIME YOU ENTER AND EXIT THE WATER.



**WRONG!**

THE FIN DOES NOT NEED TO BE REMOVED WHEN NOT IN USE. IF YOU DO NEED TO REMOVE IT SIMPLY REVERSE THESE STEPS MAKING SURE NOT TO LOSE YOUR SUP BOLT HARDWARE.

ACCIDENTS DO HAPPEN AS A RESULT OF RUNNING THE BOARD AGROUND IN SHALLOW WATERS. THATS WHY WE HAVE ENGINEERED OUR FINS TO HAVE A FAIL SAFE BREAK AWAY TAB.
